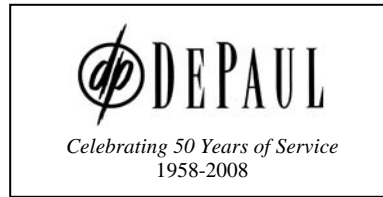

DePaul's T-Shirt Factory Expands Services

The DePaul T-shirt Factory, located in Rochester, NY, has expanded its services and is now offering custom premium imprint products. T-Shirt Factory customers can order items such as coffee mugs, plaques, awards, mouse pads, key chains and many other quality products.

Three new pieces of equipment, a sublimation printer, a heat press and a mug press, enable T-Shirt Factory staff to imprint a specific image like a photograph onto one or more select items. The equipment prints a transfer that is applied to the product through a heat-transfer process using the heated press or mug press which permanently affixes the image to the product.

JD Curran, T-Shirt Factory Manager, describes the new capabilities as, "a high tech iron-on, but better." "The process is permanent and the image cannot be peeled off," Curran explained.
