\$18 million apartment project under construction in Schenectady

Construction has officially started on the 51-unit Joseph L. Allen Apartments development in Schenectady, New York's Hamilton Hill neighborhood.

The \$17.9 million state-funded affordable housing project, which gets its name from the city's first African-American city councilman, is under development by Rochester-based DePaul Properties.

The project at the 52,500-square-foot building on Albany Street is part of Gov. Andrew Cuomo's \$10 billion HouseNY 2020 program, which seeks to create or preserve 100,000 affordable housing units over the next five years.
