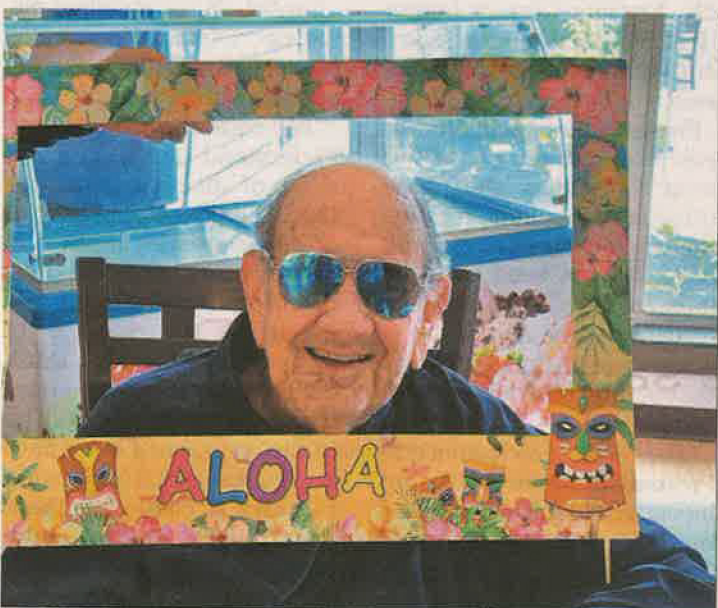


Inspiring Generations at Wheatfield Commons
